Rear Admiral Kirpal Singh, Chairman of the Company, is also the Chief Promoter.

He joined the Indian Navy in 1943 and received his initial training with the Royal Navy from 1943 to 1946. He actively served on Russian Convoys and the Okinawa campaign during World War II. He is a graduate of the Defense Services Staff College, India, Joint Services Staff College, UK and the Royal College of Defense Studies, London.

He has held many important appointments during his Naval career, including command of various ships and establishments, such as the aircraft carrier VIKRANT and the Western Fleet. His other appointments included ADC to Shri C. Rajagopalachari, Deputy Naval Advisor to the Indian High Commissioner in U.K., Director of Personnel at Naval Headquarters and Director General Naval Dockyard Expansion Scheme Bombay.

Rear Admiral Kirpal Singh was awarded the Ati Vashist Seva Medal in 1968 for his contribution to Human Resource Development of the Navy.

After retiring from the Navy, he was the Indian representative for Balfour Beatty Engineering Ltd. UK, for two years before the incorporation of Dolphin Offshore Enterprises (India) Ltd.

He is a Director in Dolphin Offshore Projects Ltd., Kanika Shipping Ltd. and Dolphin Offshore Shipping Ltd.

He is the Chairman of Managing Committee and a Member of Share Transfer Committee.
